
INTRODUCTION

 - Could analyzing these launches help me create an effective (and FUN) marketing plan for The Spanish Diplomat's Secret?



On a separate note, do you have a newsletter to customers where we can share information about my upcoming book?

The Spanish Diplomat's Secret is scheduled to be published by Macmillan in September - see the book cover attached. The graphic is based on the SS Queen Elizabeth, which is rather later than the era in my book (1894!) but gives the sense of a ship as a floating city. This is the third book of my series.

Summary: Captain Jim and Lady Diana must unravel the murder of a diplomat aboard the *SS Etruria*, and do it before they dock, or risk war between nations. With a thousand suspects and no witnesses, our sleuths get to work, but then strange omens appear onboard. Soon, a host of passengers and crew appear to have motives for murder, yet there's no evidence pointing to anyone. Worse still, Captain Jim is plagued with seasickness. Fortunately, he has a secret weapon: young Diana knows her way about luxury liners and gilded age society. But something has been troubling her too, something she won't tell Jim. As the beleaguered ship nears Liverpool, Captain Jim and his bride race to solve a mystery with dire international consequences, while dealing with the puzzles of couple-hood.




Website draws ~60 visits/week

- I started with WIX.com (\$45/year) using a template....it sold my site to Vistaprint.com
- Which sold my site WEBS.COM (\$320/year)
- So, I moved to Wordpress.com (\$40/year +\$12/domain), set up and maintain my own site.
- If you don't have time, hire a professional to set up a BASIC site with your books and bio.



My monthly author-newsletter takes ~1 hour GOAL: Invite engagement and sales



Mailchimp.com \$26/mo

- In 2023 I started with 400 readers
- Added 1400 friends/colleagues
- Monthly newsletters generate engagement, variety, conversations
- KEEP IT SHORT! No more than 3 things!
- USE PICTURES make it personal




